The Sectorial Commission for the Quality in Information and Communication Technologies (CS03) has been developing its activity since 1993 in the Portuguese Institute for Quality (IPQ), initially under the National Quality Council (CNQ), and currently under the Portuguese System of Quality (SPQ). The overall objectives of CS03 focus on the analysis, promotion and dynamization of the various components that affect Quality of products and services. It also prepares recommendations for Quality improvement in the sector of Information and Communications Technologies in Portugal. CS03 will hold from September 29 to October 2, 2010 the *7th International Conference on the Quality of Information and Communications Technology* (QuaTIC'2010). This event, that happens every three years, takes place in Porto (http://www.fe.up.pt/quatic10). The previous edition, QuaTIC'2007, held successfully in September 2007 in Lisbon (http://quatic2007.dsi.uminho.pt/), was sponsored and supported by several entities, among which stand out: Caixa Geral de Depósitos, Portugal Telecom, Critical Software, Microsoft Portugal, EDP, Portuguese Association of Certification, Foundation for Science and Technology, Portuguese Institute for Quality, New University of Lisbon, University of Minho, Faculty of Engineering of the University of Porto, European Organization for Quality Software Group, itSMF Portugal, APDSI, Order of Engineers, APQ and ipBPM.
